Galatians 5:1-3 (TPT)

Galatians 1:6-10 (ref)

- False teachers were preaching something besides Jesus and the good news of righteousness by faith {a form of judgment}

Galatians 2:16-21 (NLT)

- Made right by faith vs. obeying the law
- If we could be made right by law, Christ would not have had to die. (vs. 21)
- Law of Moses / Self-imposed law / Law of others

[Why the law?]

Galatians 3:19-25 (NLT)

1. Added because of sin
2. It was temporary
3. Protect us from sin
4. Put a restraint on sin (Did not make you holy, but restrained unholiness)
5. With the law came wrath (curses and punishment for sin)
Romans 4:15 / Deuteronomy 28 / Galatians 3:10

Galatians 4:21-31 (ref) Abrahams two children

- Two covenants (Natural/Spiritual)
- Hagar/Ishmael = law and bondage
- Sarah/Isaac = faith and freedom

Galatians 5:4-10 (TPT)

- Free from law
 - All of its regulations
 - All of its curses
 - All of its guilt
 - All of its shame
