### “What Are We to Do?”

#### ***I Chronicles 12:32-33 (NLT)***

- What are the signs of our times?
- What do we do?

#### **[Why is this important?]**

1. There is an agenda, not just a philosophy
  - a. It must be opposed
  - b. “Militant Marxism is dangerous”
  - c. God is revealing what “MOB RULE” and no law enforcement looks like!
2. Riots and anarchy are not protected under the Bill of Rights NOR Scripture (*Hebrews 12:14 / Romans 14:19*)
  - a. This will not end well; no heroes, no names to remember.
  - b. It is evil and unacceptable
3. We must oppose all forms of racism
  - a. The racism of the left/ professors and media
    - i. (Racism is a sin of the heart that knows no color)
  - b. We must judge based on character, not color
  - c. Man looks on outer appearance...God looks on the heart (*1 Samuel 16:7*) (*2 Corinthians 5:16*)
4. The result of anarchy is more brokenness, pain and division
  - a. We have real problems that continue to need addressed:
    - i. Prison reform / Drug addiction
    - ii. Collapse of nuclear family / Human trafficking
    - iii. Abortion laws / Adoption system and foster care
    - iv. Honor Authorities
    - v. Education reform (School choice)

#### **[What Do We Do?]**

1. Be loyal to Jesus both living and written (*Romans 3:4*)
2. Be reconciled to God and one another – (*2 Corinthians 5:19*)
  - a. Racial reconciliation comes from God (ministry of reconciliation)
  - b. No divisions or strife

- c. Common morals and values
  - d. Resist stereotyping and false judgments
- 3. New identity realities (*2 Corinthians 5:17*)
- 4. Seek the Kingdom first – *Matthew 6:33 / Romans 14:17*
- 5. Vote (How to vote) Register!
  - a. People who love the US
  - b. People the mainstream media hate
  - c. People who will protect the innocent and punish the guilty (*Romans 13:1-7 / 1 Timothy 2:2 / 1 Peter 2:14*)
  - d. Will not use power against us (servants)
- 6. Teach our children to trust and believe God
  - a. Prejudice media / Socialist professors
  - b. Don't be afraid or ashamed
  - c. Make disciples (*Matthew 28*)
    - i. Be a disciple of Jesus
