Dismayed (Heb):

- Discouraged / a sense of dread
- To break down either by violence, confusion, or fear

Ex. – 1 Chronicle 22:13 “...be strong and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed”

Ex. – Joshua 1:9 “Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed; for I am with you, wherever you go.”

1 Samuel 30:6-7 KJ (David at Ziklag)

- Greatly distressed
- Encouraged himself in the Lord
- Sought God (Ephod)

2 Chronicles 20: (Jehoshaphat overcoming)

1. “Our eyes are on you” (vs. 12)
2. “Be not afraid nor dismayed; the battle is not yours but the Lords” (vs. 15)
3. “Go down against them” (vs. 16)
 - a. “Faith doesn’t disengage”
4. Set / stand / see (vs. 17)
5. Sing and praise (vs. 21)
